The Melvin Jones Fellowship (named in honor of the founder of Lions International) is a recognition of a Lion making humanitarian service possible. To receive a Melvin Jones Fellowship (MJF) pin an individual makes donations that eventually add up to \$1,000. To go on to receive Progressive MJF (PMJF) pin(s), they continue to donate to Lions Clubs International Foundation (LCIF).

All MJF and PMJFs should wear their pins proudly as it shows your support of changing the world. When disaster strikes, LCIF responds immediately. For example, when an earthquake struck Turkey and Syria, \$200,000 was sent to Turkey the day it happened. Most people would think that this money was used to provide the residents with food, water, shelter, etc. However, the immediate need was to help the people who were found alive who had been buried for days. Their organs were shutting down as they had no food or water. They needed portable dialysis machines, which is what they were able to get because Lions donated to LCIF. We saved lives. The power of LCIF!

Sadly, the disasters keep occurring, but LCIF will keep supporting the efforts of the Lions wherever they occur. Our donations also provide grant opportunities for Lions to complete projects that might otherwise be out of their reach. There are ten (10) different types of grants available. An explanation of each and how to apply can be found at lionsclubs.org. Your LCIF District Coordinators can help you through the process.

So, let's make this year the time when every Lions Club and every individual Lion makes a donation to our Foundation, so we can continue to provide service from the heart as we change the world.



Wendy Southwell



In January 2023, she made history when she was appointed as Presiding Justice of the Appellate Term of the New York State Supreme Court, 2nd, 11th, and 13th Judicial Districts. The appointment marked her as the first woman, first person of color and first Trinbagonian-American to hold this prestigious position.

In January 2020, Justice Toussaint began service as an Appellate Term Associate Justice, hearing appeals, from New York City Criminal Court, Civil Court and its Housing and Small Claims Parts; for the counties of Brooklyn, Queens, and Staten Island. Her judicial journey initially began in 2002 with her election to the New York City Civil Court in Kings County; with interspersed assignments to New York City Criminal Court and New York State Family Court. She was designated an Acting Supreme Court Justice in 2010 and elected to the State Supreme Court, Kings County, in 2014. Currently, in addition to her role as Presiding Justice she continues to manage a case inventory and serves as a trial judge of the Kings County Supreme Court.

Justice Toussaint's academic credentials include a Bachelor of Arts from City College of New York and a Juris Doctor, cum laude, from Howard University School of Law. Admitted to practice in New York State, the Southern and Eastern Federal District Courts of New York, and the United States Supreme Court, her legal career spans over 40 years. This includes roles as an Assistant Corporation Counsel for the City of New York, an associate at a private law firm, and managing her own private law practice. She also served with distinction in the New York State Unified Court System as a Principal Court Attorney/Law Clerk to four judges.

Her involvement extends beyond the courtroom. Justice Toussaint serves on the Board of Directors of the Supreme Court Justices Association of the City of New York, is the Nominations Committee Chair of The Judicial Friends, Inc., and is a past president of the Association of Black Women Attorneys. Her community engagement is equally notable, including her role as a board member of Reimagine Church of the Nazarene, Inc., a member of the global General Board of the Church of the Nazarene, Inc., as well as past board chairperson of both Hope City Empowerment, Inc., and Protestant Board of Guardians, Inc.

Justice Toussaint's career is adorned with numerous professional and community awards, each recognizing her profound impact on the legal field and her dedicated service to the community. Her service is a testament to her high standards and dedication to the pursuit of justice. In all she does, she never forgets to give God thanks for her blessings seen and unseen, which equip and empower her with strength and courage to render justice with mercy.



Lion Paula Spann


